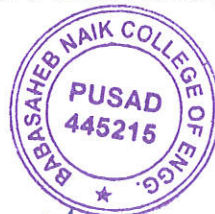

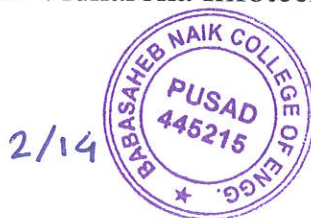

The Institute hosts students from culturally and economically very diverse backgrounds but the Institute is very accommodative to the heterogeneity and provides a very safe and congenial environment for growth. Committee to support and vigilate like ragging prevention are at place.

In this session **1205** undergraduates are pursuing engineering degree on the campus while **9** students were enrolled for post-graduation programs in this session. College has facilitated students for the benefit of the government schemes for socially and financially backward classes like free ships, scholarships, free ship for girl student, maintenance allowances etc in the session 2024-25. About 1012 students have been benefited.

cell works to develop the self-confidence of Women and to guide about Women Welfare Laws, health and hygiene by organizing talks, seminars, workshops relating to the issues.

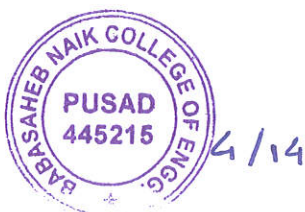

Mr. Om Duparte and Ms. Payal Shirbhate were nominated as NSS student representatives.

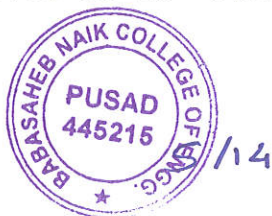

In library the Swayam-Prabha is a group of 32 DTH channels devoted to telecasting of high-quality Educational programmes on 24x7 basis using the GSAT-15 satellite. Book-Bank facility is provided to 20 meritorious students from each semester (All Branches) free of cost. All **SC / ST** students get book bank facility under Social Welfare Scheme. Around 350 students avail this book bank facility. Homage is paid to National leader & Social Reformers on their Birth & Death anniversaries.

Engico student's consumer co-operative with prime objective of fulfilling everyday requirements of students is functioning with eagerness. Papers, stationery, drawing sheets, Engineering Drawing instruments, Books, daily need items and general items are available at reasonable rate in the store.

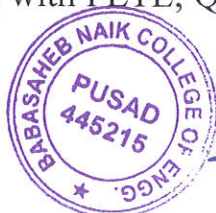
In Student counseling cell many students avail the facility of personal counseling on decision making, health, psychological issues, academic support etc., with support of mentors and wardens.

Department of Civil Engineering

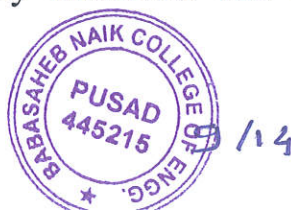

Department of Workshop

Being central facility, Workshop department provides all possible guidance and help to the students of various branches for their practical work. Practical training of second Year B.E. (Mech.) students is carried out in the workshop. B.E. First year (all branches) student practical are also conducted; this department is playing major role in fabrication of projects for final year students of various branches.



Dr. H.B. Nanvala worked as in charge of Institute Innovation council, Workshop staff are rendering their services to social work, Maintenance work, etc.

The faculty of our college has numerous academic achievements like every year. This year the faculty published 18 research papers in National and International Journals and Conferences. Patents have been registered. Faculty have participated in 67 number of FDP's at various venues, while few have participated in workshops, coursework and webinars. 5 of the faculty have delivered expert lectures at reputed venues.

Every year on 26th January & 15th August celebrations include inhouse circlet matches.

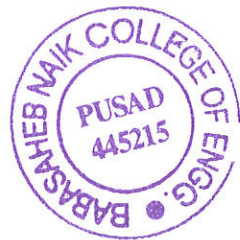
On 29 th August 'National Sports Day' was celebrated to commemorate the birth anniversary of legendary hockey player Major Dhyan Chand.
